"I am extremely disappointed that there is no public backlash against the actions of Ms Brook as if the genders were reversed then their rightly would be. It would then lead the news agenda, politicians would be speaking out and social media would be alive with comment. Sadly, because men are the victims there is a deathly silence which shows how far we need to go before all victims of domestic abuse are treated the same."
